INTERNSHIP PROGRAM

Each summer, SLC welcomes several college students to our summer internship program. These interns become part of our team and valued participants on current projects. We provide interns with a variety of projects at different stages of completion, exposing them to job-site and office responsibilities so they experience both the technical side of construction as well as the management and financial aspect of an ongoing project. Our interns learn the importance of client relationships, communication, accountability and team participation. Interns work at the level of a project engineer and meet weekly with a mentor and program coordinator to ensure a meaningful experience that can be tailored to specific interests.

WORK OPPORTUNITIES

As a general contractor, construction and management of construction projects is our primary business. Whether on-site or in the office, interns will work alongside different team members as they oversee and execute different aspects of projects, from preconstruction to close-out. Each intern will spend 5 weeks in the field, 5 weeks in the project management, and 2 weeks in preconstruction/estimating.

In project management, interns will work with project managers (PMs), assistant PMs, and project engineers to experience the collaboration between architects, owners, subcontractors. They will also learn how SLC staff function as a project team in a collaborative environment to ensure successful completion of complex projects.

Working in the field with our senior superintendents, interns will experience different job-site phases from site work to finish, as well as field management, subcontractor coordination, organization and execution of punch lists, and safety training,

The Preconstruction/Estimating phase will provide interns with an overview of contracts, contract delivery methods, blueprint reading and Gradebeam. Interns will also participate in quantity takeoffs, scoping trades, contacting subs, and participate in a bid.
